

Descriptive of School Environmental Conditions on Student Learning Achievement

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Abstract. This study investigates the important role of school environment conditions on student learning achievement at Muhammadiyah Junior High School 1 Sidoarjo, which emphasizes moral and ethical values. Using a qualitative approach, data were collected through observations and interviews over approximately five days. The results revealed positive habits such as 3s (smile, greeting, salutation), adequate facilities, and effective learning processes. Play an important role in improving student learning achievement. Teachers at the school contribute greatly to character development and achievement by motivating students. The impact of these activities can improve strong morale, good social skills, high motivation, and quality learning ability.

I. INTRODUCTION

Education is the foundation for the development of individuals and society in the context of education. the school environment plays an important role in shaping student achievement. research shows that the quality of the learning environment has a significant impact on academic performance with factors such as adequate infrastructure conducive atmosphere and modern facilities positively influencing student outcomes.[1] This is because these behaviors have a significant impact on the law of learning in schools and student well-being. Overall through the literature review, we understand that students' inappropriate behavior when interacting with teachers and lack of tolerance towards peers have special needs. II. METHOD

Data collection is done through direct observation, After the data is collected, the analysis will be done qualitatively with an inductive approach that allows researchers to explore the meaning of the data in depth in the process of data collection media used, which includes photos and voice recordings. Taking photos will enable detailed visual capture of the observed situations and conditions, providing a more concrete and real picture. Meanwhile, voice recordings will record conversations and interactions between participants, generating verbal data that can be analyzed to better understand the context and dynamics of the communication taking place. These two media will be valuable tools for obtaining in-depth information about the case under study. The data to be analyzed includes the results of interviews with participants, the results of direct observation, and also information contained in related documents. The research was conducted from April 29 to May 5, 2024. This approach is expected to provide insight into how the school environment plays an important role in the student learning process.

III. FINDINGS AND DISCUSSION

A. Findings

This research was conducted by means of observations and interviews which showed that the junior high school Muhammadiyah 1 Sidoarjo is committed to character building and the development of student learning achievement in a positive school environmental culture. Student ethics plays an important role in influencing student achievement in school.[4] Research shows that schools with a strong ethos and values-based policies tend to have higher academic achievement, which in turn correlates with lower psychological distress and aggressive behavior among students, ultimately impacting their overall well-being and academic success.[5] The implementation of active problem-based learning model can also significantly improve student achievement in ethics courses, emphasizing the importance of active student learning and problem-based approach in improving academic success.[6] In Islamic education, ethical values such as respecting teachers, seeking knowledge for the sake of Allah, and doing good deeds are highlighted as important for students' success in learning.[7]

B. Discussion
